The fifth International Conference of Animal Health Information Specialists will be held at the University of Pretoria, Onderstepoort, South Africa, July 4th through July 7th. The theme for the conference is "Running wild, running free: capturing, harnessing and disseminating knowledge flows in support of animal health."

The conference program includes tours of local animal health facilities as well as keynote speakers and papers. In addition to the conference program, there are four days of pre-conference workshops and a full schedule of social programming, featuring a night drive on the Rietvlei Nature Reserve and a Safari Ban-

quet at the National Zoo. There are two optional trips after the conference. Friday, July 8, take a day trip to Cradle of Humankind (Sterkfontein Caves) and Rhino & Lion Park near Krugersdorp, or stay for the extended weekend trip to Kruger National Park, Saturday, July 9 to Tuesday, July 12th. The deadline for early registration is April 30th and late registration ends June 15th.

VMLS HOSTS EXHIBIT TABLE AT AVMA ANNUAL CONFERENCE: HOW WE DID IT AND WHAT WE LEARNED

The American Veterinary Medical Association held its annual conference in Philadelphia this past July. VMLS decided to investigate the idea of hosting its own exhibit booth. In previous years, VMLS would participate at NLM's booth, but this year, AVMA was not on NLM's exhibit schedule. So VMLS ran it alone! This article will describe how we put the exhibit together, what we decided to display, and why at least one visitor to our booth thought we were "worth the price of admission" to the conference!

As we began to plan for the exhibit, the obvious obstacle was the expense. Although AVMA does not charge a fee for a non-profit exhibit booth, there is a fee of \$200.00 for each exhibitor's badge. \$200.00 would get us one exhibitor's badge, a table, two chairs, and a wastebasket. We were going to need more than that for a suitable exhibit! Computer rental and Internet access were expensive, depending upon speed, monitor type, etc. Although badges could be shared by more than one person, we strongly desired two badges so that we could have two people at the booth at a time. We needed to create a banner and have handouts produced. Clearly the Section could not afford all of the expenses involved.

After approaching NLM for a contribution towards the exhibit, it was suggested that we apply for a NN/LM Exhibit Award of up to \$2000.00. We were awarded that amount. As we came up with a budget to justify our application for the award, we chose to put the money towards two quality computers, flat screen monitors, and ISDN Internet access. We also approached CAB International for a donation, since we decided to include their AnimalScience.com database in the exhibit. In talking with Susanne Whitaker, we decided that Cornell and Penn would share the expense of creating and duplicating promotional material, including a banner and various handouts. It was also agreed that the Section would contribute toward the cost of two exhibitor badges. Now, we had money to work with!

The decision as to what to include was based upon input from VMLS members via our listserv and consultation with two volunteer colleagues at Penn: Frank Campbell, the liaison librarian for the Veterinary, Dental and Biomedical Libraries; and Melanie Cedrone, Biology Liaison Librarian (with a background in animal science) at the Biomedical Library. I could not have managed to put the exhibit together and man the

MASSEY UNIVERSITY: PALMERSTON NORTH, NEW ZEALAND

Massey University's Institute of Veterinary, Animal and Biomedical Sciences' veterinary program was the first to be accredited by the AVMA in the southern hemisphere. Massey University was founded in 1927 in Palmerston North, on the lower North Island about 90 miles from Wellington. Palmerston North is a city of over 73,000 people and has been dubbed a "little Amsterdam" by some residents. The Manawatu River divides the Palmerston North branch into two campuses, with the veterinary school housed amongst the trees and gardens of the Turitea Campus.

The Massey University Library began in 1964, about the same time as the vet program. Though there are 70 library staff serving the Turitea Campus, only Rae Gendall and Bruce White are liaison librarians for the College of Sciences, which includes the Veterinary Institute. They subscribe to 18 of the 20 top-ranked veterinary science titles, with most of them available online. Rae and Bruce support the Veterinary Institute through book and journal selection, research consulta-

tions for staff and postgraduate students, and information skills classes for undergraduate students.

The Massey University Bachelors of Veterinary Science is the only qualification available in New Zealand that is recognized by the Veterinary Council for registration—a requirement for practicing as a veterinarian in New Zealand. The degree takes five years and includes at least 14 weeks of practical farm work and another 14 weeks of veterinary practical work. New Zealand students have a tradition of playing tricks known as "capping stunts" during their graduation week. One such stunt included the release of a small pig on the top floor of the Massey University Library. Bruce had to tackle and hold it down until they could pen it up. He attests that pigs are not so good at respecting a library's quiet hours—be forewarned! booth without their help. In addition, Carol Elmore, from Kansas State, attends the exhibit each year with her veterinarian spouse. She volunteered many hours during her stay to man the booth, and her veteran experience in attending AVMA in the past was invaluable.

On the listserv, there was consensus that we should focus on PubMed and include general information about NLM resources and services. This was emphasized in the NN/LM grant proposal, but we also stated that we would exhibit other resources as well. There was disagreement on the listserv as to whether we should include Agricola or not. There was also disagreement as to whether we should include fee-based veterinary information services available on the Web. There was general agreement that CAB was the most comprehensive resource for veterinary literature, and we learned on the listserv of an interface produced by CABI called AnimalScience.com. It was available for subscription to individuals! This was news to many of us. Until now, we thought CAB access was largely restricted to those affiliated with universities. But now we learned that graduates and practitioners could continue to have access at an affordable subscription rate.

We decided to limit the exhibit to PubMed and NLM resources, as well as Animal Science.com. Since none of the exhibit booth volunteers were familiar with the Animal-

Science.com interface, we arranged with CABI for a live training session over the web. Carol participated from Kansas State, while Frank, Melanie and I participated together at the Penn Library.

Our handouts included the VMLS brochure about searching PubMed, PubMed and LoansomeDoc fact sheets, and a handout we created with information about copy services for obtaining articles from various schools of veterinary medicine.

It was perhaps 50/50 as to whether people who stopped at our booth knew about PubMed. None of the visitors knew about the VMLS PubMed handout, and all were happy to receive a copy. Most visitors did not know about AnimalScience.com, and surprisingly, in fact, seemed unfamiliar with CAB in general. Some had an appreciation for the value of the database, but many found the \$150 subscription rate to be too expensive. Many visitors had questions or misconceptions about obtaining the full text of articles, and many were happy to receive our document delivery/copy service handout. We estimate that we spoke to or put something into the hands of about 230 people. We may have reached even more people had our booth been more centrally located. Instead, we were in the last aisle, and only determined conference attendees would venture that far.

While many visitors took a handout, a pen, or piece of candy and moved on, others did stop to learn more. In fact, some

stumped us with their questions! One veterinarian said she had been unable to find information on a certain type of Chinese acupuncture, even though she knew articles had been written. We, too, failed to find the articles in either PubMed or CAB. Another person wanted veterinary information on a particular blood disorder. We could only find lab animal information, despite the combined use of our best searching skills.

Despite the NN/LM grant, the donation from CAB, and the contribution from VMLS, our exhibit booth was still bare-bones! Our one table was crowded, with the two computers, the handouts, and candy and NLM and CAB pens as giveaways. Two tables would have been great. And we were one of the very few booths that did not rent a carpet! By the end of the weekend, our tired feet noticed the lack of a soft carpet, and surely a carpet would have improved the aesthetics of the exhibit. We also would have done better with a counter-height table for doing database demos. Since Carol was able to use her spouse badge, there were times when three of us were at the booth, and a third chair would have been appreciated.

We all enjoyed the experience, and were struck at how family-oriented the AVMA conference was compared to our MLA conferences. There were numerous spouses and children visiting the exhibits, and many events seemed to be planned for families. It would be unusual to see strollers in the aisles at MLA, but not at AVMA.

One excursion we took from our exhibit booth was when Melanie and Susanne Whitaker, who happened to be at the conference, sat in on a session about veterinary information available on the Internet. According to Melanie, the veterinarian presenter did a good job showing PubMed and other resources! However, we all remarked that it would be wonderful if in the future, a librarian would be included in that type of session.

Another excursion was when I attended the veterinary history meeting. Our own Susanne Whitaker is the current treasurer, and our own Trenton Boyd was doing a presentation on antique veterinary postcards!

So, you may still be wondering, why did someone give us a bear hug at our booth and exclaim that we were worth the price of admission? It was when Melanie showed PubMed's Citation Matcher to a non-veterinarian editor.
